

ID Requirements For Your PNCB Exam

Don't forfeit your fees! To enter a Prometric Testing Center for your exam, **you must present two forms of identification, one with a current photograph. All documentation must be in your legal name.**

Both forms of ID **must be current and include the candidate's current first and last name, signature, and match the name on the exam application.** You may also opt to use 2 primary IDs from column 1.

If your name changes prior to your scheduled examination or your ID/name on exam application do not match, you must contact PNCB by emailing exam@pncb.org or calling 1-888-641-2767 regarding this change.

<p>Marriage license/certificate or divorce degree is NOT acceptable at the Prometric Test Center. Name changes must be made with PNCB at least 5 business days prior to exam date.</p>	
<p>Temporary ID, social security cards, computer-generated copies of RN licenses and ID cards such as PALS, ACLS, etc. are NOT acceptable.</p>
