## WHAT THEY DO


Thank you, Champions, for supporting certification for your colleagues! Here are just a few of the ways they made a difference in 2018:


97% spoke to RNs informally



## **NEW IN 2018**

## Choice for annual Champion benefit.

In the past, Champions with at least 1 full year of service would receive free Recert.

But with many Champions receiving reimbursement or No Pass, No Pay support to pay for Recert, PNCB offered a choice between the Recert voucher or a high end lunch tote.

For 2018, 43 (23%) chose the tote.

#### Downloadable greeting cards.
