RNs with a diploma, associates, bachelors, masters, or doctoral nursing degree who meet the following criteria can apply. See website for full eligibility details.

- 1. Current, active, unrestricted RN license in the U.S., Canada, and select U.S. territories
- 2. Completed experience which meets the requirements of one of the pathways below:

PATHWAY 1

√ 1,800 hours as an RN in pediatric nursing within the past 24 months

PATHWAY 2

- ✓ A minimum of 5 years as an RN in pediatric nursing and
- 3,000 hours in pediatric nursing within the last 5 years **with**
- ✓ A minimum of 1000 hours within the past 24 months

What Counts for Pediatric RN Practice?

 Pediatric direct patient care or indirect care such as teaching, administration, clinical research, school-based care, home health care, or consultation
