

Ready to get CPN certified in pediatrics?

You have the No Pass, No Pay benefit here.

Ask your employer's No Pass, No Pay contact for a code. You will pay no money to apply. If unsuccessful, no exam fee is charged by PNCB. Please make a study plan and prepare well prior to taking the exam.

To prepare for the exam, use the CPN checklist at www.pncb.org. Your employer supports your journey to certification. Ask about resources available here where you work.

PNCB now offers two exam eligibility pathways:

- 1800 hours of pediatric RN clinical practice within the past 24-months -OR-
- A minimum of 5 years as an RN in pediatric nursing and 3,000 hours in pediatric nursing within the last 5 years with a minimum of 1000 hours within the past 24 months.
