Reinstatement of Certification

It is the policy of PNCB to provide an opportunity for certificants who have not completed recertification requirements and allowed their credential status to lapse to regain their certification without having to retake the examination if reinstatement is completed within one year of the lapse date of the credential(s).

Certificants may only reinstate an individual credential one time and within one year of having the credential lapsed. All recertification requirements must be met in order to be eligible to reinstate. Detailed information for certificants wishing to pursue reinstatement is available on the PNCB web site.

Certificants who are not successful in reinstating within the one year may consider retaking the exam if all current exam eligibility criteria are met. Certificants also have the option to submit an appeal to the Appeals Committee/Executive Committee of the PNCB Board of Directors.
